

Course Setter Notes for Camp Wisdom 2022

Start and Finish –

The start area is located about 150m southeast of the main parking lot and registration tables. The finish is immediately South of the large pavilion South of the main parking lot.

NOTE: The Start Triangle will be marked with a standard control bag. It will not have a number or punch. Do not confuse the start triangle with control number 1 on your course.

Fences –

Un-crossable fences surround the camp. Fences inside the camp enclose shooting areas and mark off private property. There is not a need to cross any fences during the competition.

Trails –

Trails are fairly well marked and identified on the map with very few exceptions. The trails have been found to be passable but heavy vegetation obscures some and requires participants to pay close attention to their map and trail marks. Trails can be steep and overgrown in some areas so use caution.

Vegetation –

Vegetation throughout most of the camp is very dense and impassable (dark green) requiring the use of trails and roadways which will add to the overall distance for every course. Even short distances between some points will require routing around green areas and choosing the best trail to navigate.

Campsites –

This is a Boy Scout Camp with campgrounds located in all areas. Some may be occupied so please be respectful and courteous in and around these areas. Go around the edge of occupied tent areas and not run through the middle of campsites.

Shooting Areas –

Shooting areas are fenced and marked as out of bound areas on the map. Do not cross fences and try to route through these areas. Shooting may be in progress at the same time as the meet.

Restrooms –

Restrooms are located at the large pavilion just south of the main parking areas. There are also latrines located in most campsites. Please do not use latrines in occupied campsites.

Map –

The maps for all courses will be at a scale of 1:7500 with a contour of 2.5 meters. Drinking water is located at several locations convenient for all courses.

Orienteering Rules –

Remember, on the competition courses orienteering is a solo event. Working with another person of signaling a control location is grounds for disqualification. Those interested in working as a team should participate on the recreational courses.

Courses –

All courses will use EPUNCH
