Meet Director Notes

Welcome to Cooper Lake State Park, NTOA's largest mapped area. The regular set of competition courses white, yellow, orange, brown, green, and red, will be offered, with e-punch for all courses. Groups and teams are welcome, but no awards for them.

In addition to meet fees, all participants must pay Cooper State Park entry fee. There is a three-hour time limit on all courses. Even if you don't locate all of the controls, please report to the Finish within three hours. Please use courtesy around campsite areas and when walking along roads.

NTOA will follow OUSA Covid guidelines including pre-registration required, staggered start lines, no-touch e-punching for all courses, and remote download procedures.

The meet will be at the Buggy Whip area. Follow signs after entering park. Start is less than 100m from parking.
